


How to use Google Scholar for academic research

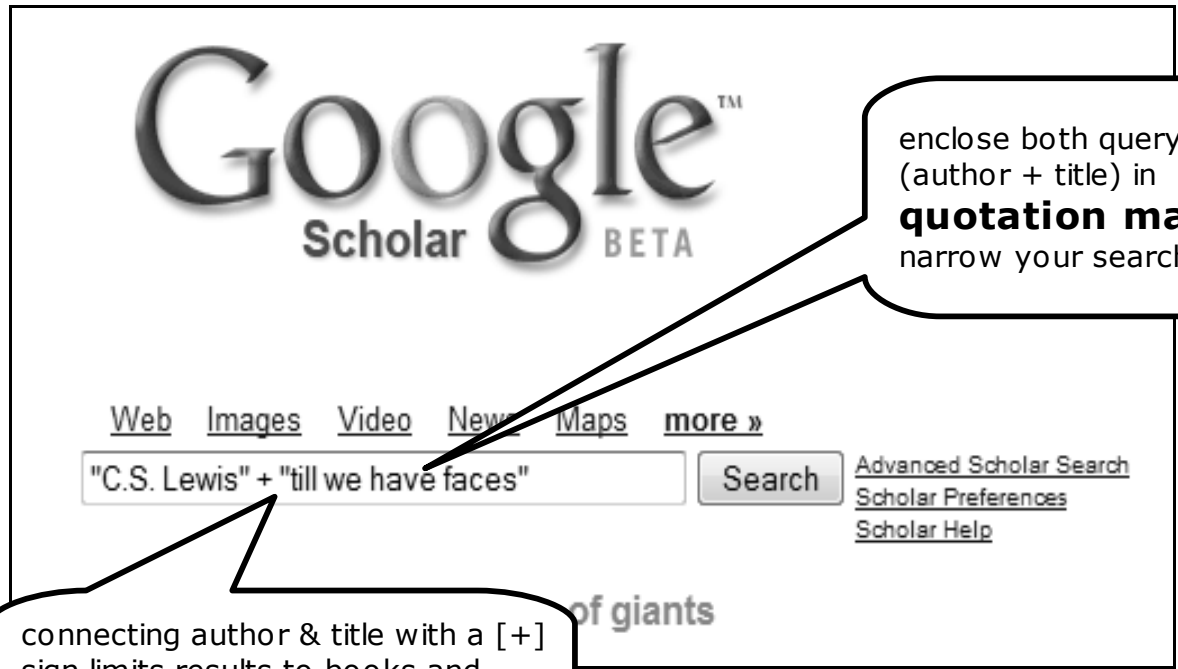
click **MORE** down arrow to launch drop-down menu

enclose both query terms (author + title) in **quotation marks** to narrow your search

connecting author & title with a [+] sign limits results to books and articles about this author **AND** this title (no Narnia, for example)



this search returned **426** results; click **RECENT ARTICLES** to eliminate older information
